

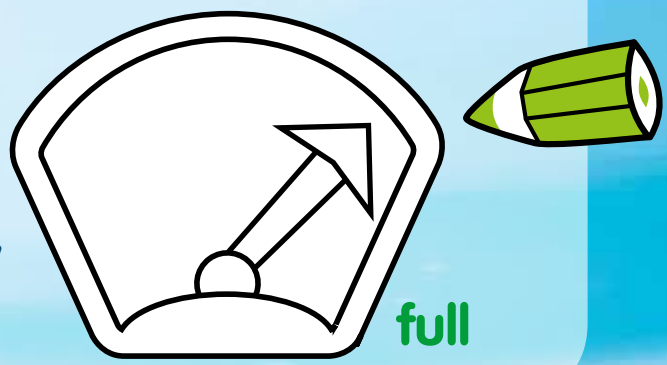


OCTONAUTS™
